# Covid policy for weekly Sacred Harp singings in Bristol

### Tue 7-9pm

Benjamin Perry Boathouse, Phoenix Wharf, Lower Guinea Street, BS1 6TJ

Anyone attending should have completed a full course of vaccination two weeks prior, whether that requires 2 doses or one dose (that is, 2 doses of the Moderna, AstraZeneca or Pfizer vaccine, or 1 dose of the Janssen vaccine).

Anyone who has received a positive test result in the past 10 days should not attend.

Anyone who is feeling unwell should not attend.

A negative test result is not required for attendance, but regular testing does reduce risk.

Masks are not required to attend.

## Contact tracing

The group will nominate a person to manage contact tracing.

Anyone attending must sign in with contact information (email or phone number).

If you develop symptoms of Covid-19 you should get a PCR test as soon as possible, and self-isolate until you get the result. <u>According to the ZOE Covid study, the main symptoms of Covid-19 have changed</u>.

Anyone who receives a positive PCR test result within five days of attending a singing must notify the contact tracer, who will contact all attendees of the singing and tell them to take a PCR test.

## Venue

Singers will be sat facing each other in four voice parts in the hollow square. Singers may sit wherever they feel comfortable.

### ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR HIRE DURING COVID-19 INFECTIVITY.

As well as our usual Conditions of Hire set out on the Booking Form, during periods of COVID-19 infectivity, these additional conditions will apply. These will be reviewed periodically.

- 1. It is the hirers responsibility to ensure that the COVID-19 requirements currently set out by HMG are in place while using our premises.
- 2. A Risk Assessment for use / occupation of the Premises must be prepared by the Hirer and shared with the Management Committee when/if requested. [Guide and Scout users must have this Risk Assessment approved by their managing Commissioner beforehand.]
- 3. Social distancing, good ventilation, hand sanitation/washing should be maintained throughout the premises. Wearing of masks is encouraged.
- 4. A Test & Trace process is in place. Hirers must record names / contact details for attendees and retain these for 21 days. The Covid App may be scanned or our Contact Sheet filled out.
- 5. A maximum of 30 people are permitted to be in the Meeting Room.
- 6. Sleepovers may take place. Numbers should be reduced to allow sensible extra spacing. [Girlguiding requires those over 11yrs have a negative result from a lateral flow test <u>before</u> attending. The Scouts advise this be done.]
- 7. Before vacating the premises, as a matter of <u>high importance</u>, hirers must clean / wipe down surfaces likely to have been touched eg tables, chairs, door furniture, toilet seats, pens etc.
- 8. Hirers are strongly advised to ensure they have full Public Liability insurance which covers use of the premises at this time.
